15th IFATSEA Africa Region Meeting concludes successfully in Kampala, Uganda

Kampala, Uganda – June 21, 2025 — The 15th International Federation of Air Traffic Safety Electronics Associations (IFATSEA) Africa Region Meeting was successfully held from **17 to 20 June 2025** at the prestigious Speke Resort Convention Centre in Kampala. Hosted on behalf of IFATSEA Africa Region by the Uganda Air Transport Safety Engineering Association (UGATSEA), the event brought together aviation safety engineering professionals, stakeholders, and experts from across the African continent.

Under the theme “**Digital Transformation in CNS/ATM: Strengthening ATSEP Competencies for a Safer and Sustainable Future**”, the four-day conference featured a high-level conversation with IFATSEA President, technical presentations and closed session discussions aimed at enhancing the safety, efficiency, and modernisation of air traffic management in the era of artificial intelligence, and other emerging technologies.

The meeting was officially opened by the Uganda Civil Aviation Authority Chairman of the Board, **Honourable Justice Dr. Steven Kavuma**, representing the **Minister of Works and Transport, Honourable General Edward Katumba-Wamala**, who emphasised the critical role of Air Traffic Safety Electronics Personnel (ATSEP) in ensuring the integrity and reliability of aviation systems. Keynote speakers included IFATSEA President Ing. Frank Kofi Apeagyei, representatives from the International Federation of Air Traffic Controllers Associations (IFATCA), Africa and Middle East Region, Mr. Tonny Keppler, Association of African Aviation Training Organisations (AATO) Secretary General, Ms Margaret Kyarwenda, and other regional industry bodies.

Highlights of the event included:

- Presentation on the evolving role of ATSEPs in the era of the fourth industrial revolution.
- Panel discussions on predictive maintenance in CNS/ATM environment, the Artificial Intelligence in Aviation – exploring the impact of AI on aviation safety and cybersecurity
- Panel discussion on regional collaboration on drones for flight inspections
- Presentation on virtualisation and remote towers in Africa.
